Form a Group and Plan Your Party

Reach out to people with whom you would like to host a party and come up with a great idea (or reach out to the Party Chairs for ideas). Meet with your group and involve everyone in the planning process to discuss all aspects of the party. Things to cover in your initial meeting:

Budget:

Do some research to determine how much the party will realistically cost. Ensure everyone agrees on the budget and work hard to stick to it.

Venue:

Where will your party be located? Consider appropriate spaces (e.g., home/backyard, restaurant, etc.). Consider how many attendees you can accommodate.

Date:

When will your party take place? Choose a few dates that will work for everyone, and make sure the venue you plan to use is available. Check the school calendar and contact the Party Board Chairs to avoid conflicts.

Food/Décor/Entertainment

Divide and conquer! Don't let one person do all the work. If hiring vendors/caterers, make sure it fits within your stated budget.

Marketing Plan:

Sell your party! Talk it up with friends and other parents, and plan on having people market your event in the party room that night during the event.
