How Does A Penny War Work? Each grade has their own coin jug for collecting money. Our teachers will even have a coin jug too! In order to add points to your jug, you must add pennies and dollar bills. Points are subtracted when silver coins are added to a jug. The objective is to add silver coins to other team jugs and keep pennies and bills in your child's team jug.

It is not about winning and it is not about losing, it is about raising money to help others!
